

Ammon L. "Smitty" Smith

Ammon L. "Smitty" Smith, 91, of Mount Joy, passed away on September 8, 2024 at Masonic Village. Born in Mount Joy, he was the son of the late Samuel and Mabel (Lehman) Smith. Ammon was the husband of Patricia (Hollinger) Smith with whom he celebrated 71 years of marriage.

Ammon was a graduate of the former East Donegal Township High School, class of 1951. He proudly served in the United States Army.
