Anthony "Tony" David Harris, 82, passed away on Tuesday, December 10, 2024 at Masonic Village, Elizabethtown. Born in St. Louis, MO, he was the son of the late John and Louise (Barby) Harris. Tony was the husband of the late Susan (Duenke) Harris (m. August 19, 1967) who passed away on February 13, 2021.

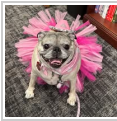
