Betty B. Eidemiller, 83, of Mount Joy, passed away on Wednesday, July 12, 2023 at Hospice and Community Care, Mount Joy with her family by her side. Born in Florin, she was the daughter of the late Victor L. and Sadie (Paup) Brooks. Betty was the wife of the late Jay R. Eidemiller who passed away on October 3, 2015.

Betty was a graduate of Donegal High School class of 1957. Betty worked for Armstrong World Industries and later M&M Mars. Betty also worked as a Radiological Technologist at various hospitals. She was a life long member of Glossbrenner United Methodist Church in Mount Joy where she was a leader of boys and girls fellowship and served on various committees. Betty was active with her husband, Jay in RETREADS Motorcycle Club. They lead tours of Lancaster County and traveled through all 48 lower continental states, lower Canadian provinces, parts of Mexico and Europe.
