Carol Ann Borry, 91, formerly of Milton Grove, passed away on Monday, March 13, 2017 at Juniper Village Senior Living at Mount Joy. Born in Lititz, she was the daughter of the late William Earle and Winifred (Maurer) Hickman. Carol was the wife of the late Henry Kenneth Borry, a World War II combat veteran, who passed away February 1, 1973.

Carol was a graduate of West Chester University with a degree in Music. She retired from the USDA as a Enumerator Supervisor. Carol was a member of Glossbrenner United Methodist Church where she was a Choir Director and taught Sunday School for many years. She served as Judge of Elections for Mount Joy Township and was also past President of the Elizabeth Hughes Society. Music was a major part of her life, she regularly played at Juniper Village on their Grand Piano. A world traveler, she has been to over 50 countries and traveled on the Concord. Carol made two crossings on the Queen Elizabeth 2.

Surviving are three children, Barrett Borry of Milton Grove, Kendace Carol Allen, wife of Keith of Bloxon, VA and April Black of Selinsgrove; six grandchildren; three great grandchildren; a sister, Nancy Streightiff of Minnesota; and a brother, David Glenn Afford of Lititz.

A funeral service honoring Carol's life will be held at Glossbrenner United

Methodist Church, 713 Church Street, Mount Joy on Friday, March 17, 2017 at 2 PM. Family and friends will be received at the church before the service from 1 PM to 2 PM.
