



## Daisley A. "Dave" Young Jr.

April 1, 1942 - June 8, 2026

Daisley A. Young, Jr., known to all who loved him as "Dave", passed away peacefully on June 8, 2026 at Pleasant View Retirement Community from natural causes. He was 84 years old.

Dave was born on April 1, 1942 in Philadelphia and was a diehard Phillies fan until the day he died. He was the son of the late Daisley A and Marion M (Heydler) Young and the husband of the late Mary Jane (Meckley) Young of Mount Joy.

Dave enlisted in the US Army in 1959 at age 17, serving six years. After his discharge from the Army, he landed his lifetime job at the Coca Cola plant in Lancaster, starting as a delivery person, then a plant manager in Mechanicsburg and working his way up the company to Vice President for MidAtlantic Coca Cola in Richmond, Virginia. He retired from Coca Cola in 1997 and he and Mary Jane moved to Cape Coral, Florida where they enjoyed a retirement boating life. Mary Jane's Parkinson's complications brought them back to Pennsylvania in 2018. Dave was a lifelong Mason.

Surviving Dave is a sister, Irene Baker (Roger) and nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by a brother, Frank Young.
