Diane M. Bennett Siegrist, 71, of Lancaster passed away unexpectedly on April 26th, 2023. She was the devoted wife of Steven Siegrist. Together, they would have celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary on May 24th, 2023. A 1970 graduate of Green Mountain High School, she later graduated from John F. Kennedy College, Wahoo, Nebraska, with a BS in Education. During her time at JFK College, Diane excelled in women's athletics.
