



Donald H. "Don" Fellenbaum

June 30, 1941 - November 26, 2023

Donald H. "Don" Fellenbaum, 82, of Mount Joy, went to his heavenly home on Sunday, November 26, 2023, surrounded by his family at Landis Homes Retirement Community following complications of pneumonia from a prolonged illness. Born in Washington Boro, he was the son of the late Robert and Miriam (Keagy) Fellenbaum. Don was the husband of Kathleen (Burkhart) Fellenbaum with whom he celebrated 60 years of marriage this past October. Don was a graduate of Penn Manor High School class of 1959 and later Thaddeus Stevens Trade School pursuing architectural drafting. He retired from Beers and Hoffman Architecture as a project manager. Following his retirement, he was employed at Manheim Auto Auction and Mount Joy Mennonite Church as custodian. Don was a member of Mount Joy Mennonite Church and taught Sunday School. He served with the Lancaster Mennonite Historical Society along with other areas of service. Don was also a member of the Central Manor Old Timers Bluegrass music group. He was an avid Philadelphia Phillies and Eagles fan. Don enjoyed travel, having been to Hawaii, Alaska, Germany, Switzerland, France, and China to assist with bringing home an adopted granddaughter, along with many other road trips. He also enjoyed collecting coins, stamps, model trains, hunting, photography, bluegrass, southern gospel, and country music.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Kathy, are three children, Keith Fellenbaum, husband of Dawne of Columbia, Kevin Fellenbaum, husband of Joy of Columbia, and Kent Fellenbaum of Mountville; seven grandchildren; a sister,

Patricia Daveler of Lititz; a brother, Kenneth Fellenbaum, husband of Debra of CT; and a sister in law, May Fellenbaum of Mount Joy.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Robert Fellenbaum.

A memorial service honoring Don's life will be held at the Mount Joy Mennonite Church, 320 Musser Road, Mount Joy, PA 17552 on Saturday, December 2, 2023 at 11 AM. Family and friends will be received at the church following the service. Interment will be private at Kraybill Mennonite Cemetery.
