Donald S. Geib, 85, of Maytown, went to be with the Lord on Monday, June 1, 2026 at Paramount Senior Living. Born in Mount Joy, he was the son of the late Paul S. and Martha (Stauffer) Geib. Don was the husband of Marilyn J. (Leakway) Geib with whom he celebrated 66 years of marriage.

Don was a graduate of Donegal High School, Class of 1958. He retired after 40 years of dedicated service with Calder Door Company, installing residential and commercial garage doors with the craftsmanship and work ethic that defined everything he did. A talented artist, Don loved to paint and had a gift for creating beauty with his hands whether it was a canvas, a woodworking project, or the mountain cabin he built himself, which became a cherished gathering spot for family and friends. He loved hunting and spending time there. Don was a member of Community Bible Church, and previously a member of Florin Church of the Brethren, where he participated in several mission trips. Outgoing and generous to his core, he never passed up an opportunity to lend a hand to a neighbor, a friend, or a stranger in need. But above all else, it was his family that meant the most to him. He cherished every moment spent with the people he loved, and made sure they always knew it.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Marilyn, are two daughters, Tracey Lehman, wife of George of Lincoln, DE and Brenda Heffelfinger, wife of Phillip of Philadelphia; five grandchildren; four great grandchildren; a brother, Paul Geib, husband of Yvonne of Manheim; and Linda Hershey, wife of John of
