Donald Milton Smith, 87, of Glenville, PA, passed away on Friday, October 27, 2023, at his residence. Born in Baltimore on April 4, 1936, he was the son of the late Milton Robert and Edna May (Behnken) Smith. Donald was the husband of Ruth (Humphrey) Smith, with whom he shared 61 happy years. He will also be missed by his three children: David Michael Smith, Gregory Richard Smith, and Amy Elizabeth Smith, and his granddaughter Zoey Wynn Sunshine Smith-Myers.
