



Elvin Knight Brenneman

July 8, 1936 - January 2, 2025

Elvin Knight Brenneman, 88, of Mount Joy, passed away on Thursday, January 2, 2025 at Paramount Senior Living in Maytown. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late John S. and Elizabeth (Knight) Brenneman. He was a graduate of Penn Manor High School class of 1954. After graduation he chose to follow his father's footsteps and began to farm. Elvin enjoyed road trips and has visited every state with the exception of North Dakota and Alaska. When he wasn't farming, he enjoyed trips to the mountains and in later years, he picked up fishing as a hobby. He attended New Danville Mennonite Church as a child and Mount Joy Mennonite Church as an adult.
