Eva C. "Honey" Kauffman, 94, formerly of Landisville, current resident of St. Anne's Retirement Community passed away on Sunday, April 16, 2023 at Hospice and Community Care, Mount Joy. Born in Mount Joy, she was the daughter of the late John and Eva (Schneider) Reigle. Eva was the wife of the late James "Jim" R. Kauffman who passed away on April 13, 2010.

Eva was a graduate of the former Mount Joy High School class of 1946. Eva married her husband, Jim on March 13, 1948 at St. Mark's United Brethren Church (now St. Mark's United Methodist Church) in Mount Joy. They were married by Dr. Ezra Ranck.

They later built their home at 660 Church Street in Landisville. They had two daughters, Karlene Acker, wife of Barry and Joanne Pearson. She had three grandchildren, Nathan Acker, husband of Abbie, Aaron Pearson, husband of Amanda, and Devon Pearson, fiancé of Maddie Rohrer; and twin great grandchildren, Ella and Grace Acker all who fondly knew her as "Graw".

Eva was the longest current living member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church. She ran the nursery for over 28 years and was active in the Dorcas Society. She served on the luncheon committee as well.

Eva was a member of the Mount Joy Leisure club, was a counselor at Pocono Plateau United Methodist Camp for many summers, and served as a Girl Scout leader for over 40 years. Eva and Jim enjoyed walking together with the Park City Twalkers group and cheering on their grandsons' sporting events and activities. Eva retired from Dutch Gold Honey in Rohrerstown in 1992

after 14 years of service.
