Francis Joseph "Frank" Glick III, 71, of Columbia, passed away on Friday, November 26, 2021 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Hagerstown, MD, he was the son of the late Francis J. Jr. and Caroline (Olsen) Glick. Frank was the husband of Jeanne (Fisk) Glick with whom he celebrated 46 years of marriage this past March 29th.
