Frederick Wilson Lahr, 76, of Mount Joy, passed away on Tuesday, September 26, 2017 at Lancashire Hall Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. Born in Dalmatia, PA, he was the son of the late Lynwood L. and Julia (Greibelbis) Lahr. Fred was the husband of Margaret "Peggy" Lahr.
