G. Robert Flick, 92, formerly of Mount Joy and Wrightsville made his peaceful exit from this world on Sunday, March 18th 2018, surrounded by loving family. A long-time resident of the Masonic Village Health Care Center, his final days were filled with family, love, smiles, tears, stories, milkshakes, Lebanon bologna, and the grace of his devoted caregivers. His heart knew peace.

Born in Lancaster, PA on November 12, 1925, "Bob" was the son of the late Charles H. Flick Jr. and Margaret Brinser Flick, and was the youngest brother of the late Margaret "Peggye" Flick and the late Charles E. Flick.

Surviving him are his children Steve (Carol) Flick; Susan (Gerald) Flick Ciranni; Donna Flick Smith, wife of the late Harold Smith; Hugh "Corky" Flick and partner Beth Newcomer Fitzpatrick.
