Georgianne R. McCue, 90, formerly of Mount Joy, passed from this earthly life to be with Jesus on Friday, July 11, 2025, at Oak Leaf Manor in Landisville, where she had resided since 2019.

Born and raised in Mount Joy, she was the daughter of George R. and Mary E. Shatto. Georgianne graduated from the former Mount Joy High School in 1952. She went on to marry her high school sweetheart, the late George Walter McCue and remained his faithful cheerleader supporting him during his professional baseball career and life's endeavors as they raised their family in Mount Joy.

Lovingly and forever known as "Nanny," she is survived by two children: Andrea M., married to Bruce Riefenstahl of Mount Joy, and Kristopher G., married to Bonnie Walter McCue of Lancaster.
