



## Harold W. "Dick" Brandt

May 16, 1933 - October 23, 2025

Harold W. "Dick" Brandt, 92, formerly of Mount Joy, passed away on Thursday, October 23, 2025 at United Zion Retirement Community. Born on May 16, 1933 in a small farmhouse on Milton Grove Road, he was the son of the late Claude and Marie (Gundlach) Brandt. Dick was the husband of Ruby (Long) Brandt with whom he would have celebrated 70 years of marriage this December 17th.

Dick was a graduate of the former Mount Joy High School class of 1952. He proudly served in the United States Army from 1953 to 1955. He worked at Servomation and later retired from Penn Dairies. Dick was a member of Mount Pleasant Brethren in Christ Church. He was an avid sportsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing trips to the cabin in Mifflinburg. Dick and Ruby were part of the Twalkers, and enjoyed walking and eating at Park City. He had a great sense of humor and cared about people.
