James Richard Yohn Jr., age 82, of Manheim, passed away peacefully on Friday, April 11, 2025, at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. Born in Lancaster, James was the son of the late James Richard Sr. and M. Arline (Hendrix) Yohn. He shared 62 cherished years of marriage with his beloved wife, Joanne (Darrenkamp) Yohn.

A 1961 graduate of Elizabethtown Area High School, James furthered his education at St. Mary's University in San Antonio, TX. He served his country with distinction in the United States Air Force. James was a dedicated member of Salem United Methodist Church in Manheim, where he contributed his time to the financial committee. A celebrated athlete, James was inducted into both the Elizabethtown High School Athletic Hall of Fame and the Susquehanna Valley Chapter, PA Sports Hall of Fame for his exceptional achievements in shot put, discus, and javelin.

James was predeceased by his son, James M. Yohn, and brother, Robert Yohn.
