



Jean A. Rajnic

April 28, 1944 - June 25, 2021

Mrs. Jean (Dino) Rajnic, RN, Mount Joy, Lancaster County, a former resident of Kline Twp., went home to her Savior and Lord on June 25 after a two-year battle with cancer.

Born in Hazleton April 28, 1944, she was the daughter of the late Vincent "Jimmy" Dino and Anna Mae (Rindock) Dino of Kelayres.

She was a 1961 graduate of the former McAdoo High School, and a 1964 graduate of the former Hazleton State General Hospital School of Nursing. She worked as a registered nurse at the former Hazleton State General Hospital, the Institute of the Pennsylvania Hospital in Philadelphia and the former Lutheran Home in Hazleton.

Jean was beloved for her vibrant faith in God which was expressed in her family, her church community, and in her work singing and preaching in prisons throughout Pennsylvania.

She is survived by her husband of 54 years, James W. Rajnic; a son, Sean, and his wife Beryl, and granddaughter Aria Rajnic Schmitt, and her husband, Christian Schmitt, a granddaughter, Aliya Rajnic; a son, Scott, and his wife, Jennifer; a granddaughter, Sophia; a grandson, Seth; a brother, James Dino, Tresckow, and many nephews and nieces.
