Jimmy Shiu Tcheou, age 33, departed to the Lord on November 20, 2020 in an automobile accident. Born March 26, 1987, Jimmy was a lifelong resident of Lancaster, PA. A faithful Catholic, Jimmy was predeceased by a brother, Saraman Tcheou, who died as an infant in an automobile accident in 1977.
