Joshua Michael Peifer, 39, of Elizabethtown passed away at home unexpectedly on Friday, February 9, 2024 after a courageous four year battle with multiple critical health issues. 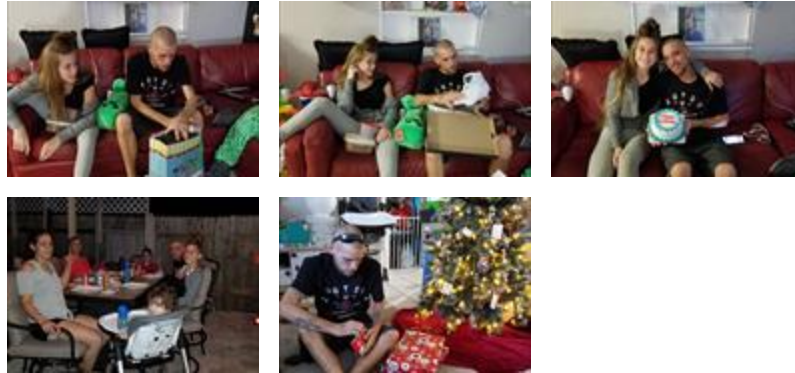

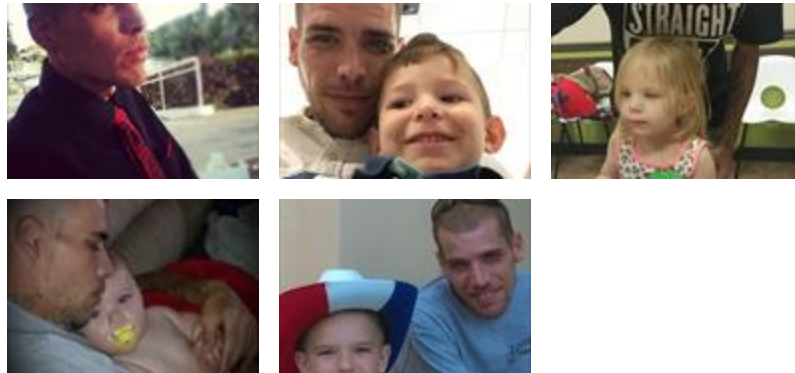
