Julia Risser Schroll, 88, formerly of Mount Joy, passed away on Saturday, June 6, 2026 at Brethren Village Retirement Community. Born in Lancaster, she was the daughter of the late Clayton L. and Rhoda (Greiner) Risser. Julia was the wife of the late Robert F. Schroll with whom she celebrated 57 years of marriage before his passing on January 18, 2018.

Before entering Elizabethtown Area High School, Julia contracted Poliomyelitis at age 13. She spent a total of two years in the Lancaster General Hospital and the Elizabethtown Hospital for Crippled Children during her recuperation. Julia reentered high school at the new Donegal High School. She was a member of Mount Joy Mennonite Church. Julia enjoyed fishing, sewing, and gardening. Along side her husband, she was on associate staff of Campus Crusaders for Christ for 20 years.

Surviving are three children, Valerie Evanson, wife of Joel of Phoenixville, PA, Angela Schroll, wife of Jude Fernando of Worchester, MA, and Neil Schroll of Mount Joy; two grandchildren, Shane Evanson of Phoenix, PA and Jadon Fernando of Worchester, MA; and three siblings, Ann Vasilik, wife of Ken of Pittsboro, NC, Lucille Steele of Lancaster, and Clayton Risser, husband of Penny of Lancaster.

A memorial service honoring Julia's life will be held at Mount Joy Mennonite Church, 320 Musser Road, Mount Joy, PA 17552 on Saturday, June 20, 2026 at 11 AM.
