



Leroy Dale Blouch

Leroy Dale Blouch, 78, of Mount Joy, passed away on Sunday, May 14, 2023 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Lebanon, he was the son of the late Leroy Grant and Silvia (Yocum) Blouch. Dale was the husband of Barbara (Rettew) Blouch with whom he celebrated 54 years of marriage this past April 25th.

Dale was a graduate of North Lebanon High School and later Elizabethtown College. He retired from Doors and Hardware in York working as an architectural hardware consultant. Dale was a member of Trout Unlimited, Lyman Gap Hunt Club, Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation, and the Slate Run Sportsmen where he formerly served as treasurer.
