Margaret “Peggy” Nusbaum Sgrignoli Garrison of Elizabethtown, PA passed away on November 7, 2021. Born on January 25, 1941 the eldest of two children to John K Nusbaum and Elizabeth Keister Nusbaum formerly of Enola, PA. Peggy was preceded in death by her parents and brother John K Nusbaum Jr. retired USAF of Shalimar, FL.

Peggy was an active young woman playing sports and singing in choir. In October 1956 she married Carl “Rick” Sgrignoli. They had five children together: Dan (Patricia) Sgrignoli of Red Lodge, MT; Perry (Terrie) Sgrignoli of Mount Wolf, PA; Crystal (Sharky) Hostler of Three Forks, MT; Kory Sgrignoli of Morrisville, NC; and Loreena (Andy) Plouse of Franklin, NC. After 32 years of marriage and his struggle with cancer, Peggy said good-bye to Rick. She continued working as the pool manager and a Water Safety Instructor at East Pennsboro School District until she retired after 26 years of service.

Peggy loved dancing and started lessons where she met Ray Garrison, who she later married in December 1993. With this event she gained two stepsons Keith and Brian Garrison, both of Hummelstown, PA. Peggy and Ray danced, played cards and entertained friends during many holidays. After 24 years of marriage Ray passed away and Peggy moved to Elizabethtown Masonic Village, where she continued to sing in three choirs.

Peggy is survived by her children, six grandsons, seven granddaughters and nine great-grandchildren. The family is planning a memorial service in spring 2022. She will be interred next to her parents and first husband at Rolling
