Merle E. Geesey, age 84, formerly of Mount Joy, PA, entered the gates of Heaven to meet his Lord and Savior on Thursday, September 25th, 2025 at his home. He was born January 18th, 1941, in Maytown, PA. Merle was a son of the late Merle and Marion (Eisenberger) Geesey, and the husband of Gloria Anne (Peifer) Geesey with whom he celebrated 66 ½ years of marriage.

Merle, lovingly known as “Snook” to his siblings and their families, was a devoted husband, son, uncle, brother, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He was also a dedicated employee of Packaging Corporation of America from May of 1961 to May of 2006 when he retired.
