Michael A. Sager, 64, formerly of Marietta PA, passed away in Kalispell, MT. on January 30, 2024. Born March 3, 1959, he was the son of the late George and Mary Margaret Shireman Sager.

Mike was a 1977 graduate of Donegal High School, Mount Joy PA where he played soccer and basketball. He worked at the former Armstrong Carpet Plant in Marietta, the former Sager Dodge Wrightsville, and the former Nolt Chrysler AMC Jeep. Mike went on to start his landscape and mowing service and later transitioned into serving others by working for Water Street Rescue Mission of Lancaster. Mike moved to Montana in 2011 and worked for the Missoula International Airport Parking Authority. He later moved to Kalispell and began work in homeless shelters and Church Thrift Shops. He retired in 2021. An avid outdoorsman, he was an ardent fly fisherman, a stealthy elk hunter, and enjoyed hiking the mountains of northern Montana.
