Patricia G. "Pat" Alleman, 71, of Mount Joy, passed away on Tuesday, January 10, 2017 at her residence. Born in Lancaster, she was the daughter of the late Ralph and Fern (Sears) Alleman.

Pat was a member and served as the Sexton at Saint Luke's Episcopal Church in Mount Joy before her retirement in 2010.
