Patricia A. Post, 73, of Mount Joy, passed away on Friday, February 3, 2017 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Waldoboro, ME, she was the daughter of the late William and Lois (Small) Post.

After graduating high school, Pat attended New Brunswick Bible Institute in New Brunswick, Canada for 3 years and later Child Evangelism Fellowship Institute. Pat then moved back to Maine and worked as the C.E.F Director of Northern Maine for 4 years. In the mid 60's, Pat moved to Pennsylvania and joined the Pennsylvania Department of Welfare in Lancaster and was later transferred to Harrisburg for over 30 years. Pat also had a tax business for many years and gained many friends from it. She led and worked in Pioneer Clubs, taught Sunday School and has helped out many areas of her church, Calvary Bible Church in Mount Joy. She has also served on the Donegal School Board several times.

Pat is survived by a sister, Judy Gerstung of Mount Joy; three brothers, Henry Post, husband of Nancy, Richard Post, husband of Dorothy and Raymond Post; thirteen nieces and nephews; and twenty four great nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by a brother, Charlie Post and two nieces.
