Reinhold Berg, 72, of Manheim, passed away on Sunday, September 17, 2017 at Pleasant View Retirement Community. Born in Mistelbach, Germany, he was the son of the late Henry and Gretel (Keller) Berg. Reinhold was the husband of the late Florence Berg.
