Richard E. "Dick" Martin, 94, of Mount Joy, passed away on Monday, June 30, 2025 at Juniper Village. Born in Mount Joy, he was the son of the late Elwood E. and Ruth M. (Kuhn) Martin. Dick was the husband of Sarah (Brown) Martin with whom he celebrated 73 years of marriage this past June 1st.

Dick was a graduate of the former Mount Joy High School class of 1948 and later Elizabethtown College with a degree in Business Administration. He retired from the former AMP, Inc. where he worked in various positions. An active member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Dick served on numerous commissions and as Secretary for the Administrative Board.
