Robert C. "Bob" Beamenderfer, 93, of Elizabethtown, passed away on Sunday, December 4, 2022 at his residence. Born in Mount Joy, he was the son of the late William C. and Anna (Zerphey) Beamenderfer. Bob was the companion of the late Beatrice S. "Boots" Wittel who passed away on June 4, 2014.

Bob was a graduate of Mount Joy High School class of 1947, and attended Thaddeus Stevens Trade School where he studied drafting. Bob was a skilled mason & draftsman. He worked for Hershey Lumber Company, J. C. Snavelly & Sons, and J. H. Brubaker Lumber. Bob enjoyed traveling, gardening and golfing. He played golf in all 50 states. He was a member of Newtown United Methodist Church where he faithfully rang the bell on Sunday mornings. In his life, Bob drew the plans and laid the block and brick for each of his children's houses.
