Robert P. "Bob" Lively Jr., 64, of Maytown, passed away on Sunday, September 20, 2020 at Lancaster General Hospital surrounded by his family. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late Robert P. Sr. and Audra (Good) Lively. Bob was the husband of Sue A. (Hamilton) Lively with whom he would have celebrated 42 years of marriage on September 30th.

Bob was a graduate of Elizabethtown Area High School class of 1974. He retired from Donegal Mutual Insurance and previously worked 34 years at AMP (T.E Connectivity) at the Mount Joy plant. A volunteer firefighter, Bob was an active life-member of the Maytown-East Donegal Township Fire Department as well as the Elizabethtown Fire Department, Station 74. A Free and Accepted Mason, he was member of Ashara-Casiphia Lodge-551 Mount Joy and a member of Dela-Ches Fishing Association, Lawn, and was a Sons of the American Legion, Post 329.

Surviving in addition to his wife, Sue, are two children, Danielle Luttrell, wife of Chad of Maytown and Derrick Lively of Maytown. Also surviving are three grandchildren, Cody, Cayden, and Kylie Luttrell.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Michael Lively.
