Robert M. "Bob" Devenburgh, 69, of Mount Joy, passed on Saturday, October 14, 2023, after a courageous battle with cancer. Born in East Petersburg, he was the son of the late Myron and Charlotte (Dupree) Devenburgh. Bob was the loving husband of Yvonne "Bonnie" (Barley) Devenburgh with whom he celebrated 42 years of marriage.

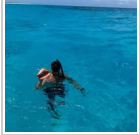
