



## Robert E. Fellenbaum

May 14, 1938 - March 25, 2017

Robert E. "Bob" Fellenbaum, 78, of Mount Joy, passed away, after a one year illness on March 25, 2017. He was the husband of May Zook Fellenbaum to whom he was married for 56 years last September. He is survived by three sons, Randall (Dorcas) Fellenbaum of Mount Joy; Rodney (Heidi) Fellenbaum of Hershey and Richard (Gwen) Fellenbaum of New Holland and six grandchildren.

Bob retired from Longenecker's Hatchery, Elizabethtown after 43 years of employment. He was a devoted member of the Elizabethtown Mennonite Church, where he served as a Deacon and taught Sunday school. Bob volunteered with the Mennonite Central Committee, enjoyed gardening, bird watching and was well known for his chicken barbeques. Most importantly, Bob will be remembered for his love of family and the special times they shared together.
