



## Robert K. "Bob" Shank

Robert K. "Bob" Shank Sr., 94, of Mount Joy died on January 27, 2025 at Lancaster General Hospital. Born in Penryn, he was the son of the late Lloyd F. and Alice (Kling) Shank. Bob was the husband of Beulah (Wolgemuth) Shank with whom he celebrated 74 years of marriage this past August 26th. Bob was a graduate of the former Mount Joy High School class of 1948. He proudly served in the United States Army during the Korean War from 1952 to 1954. He retired from the former SICO Company after 43 years of service.
