Rodney E. Myers, 75, of Mount Joy, passed away on Thursday, March 7, 2024 at the Lebanon VA Medical Center. Born in Lancaster, he was the son of the late Robert W. and Jean L. (Grubb) Myers. Rodney was the husband of the late TyAnn Myers who passed away on August 15, 2022.

Rodney was a graduate of Donegal High School class of 1966. He proudly served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War from 1968 to 1969 with the 1st Division Infantry. He was awarded two bronze stars with the V device. Rodney was a member and served as Commander of the former Veterans of the Vietnam War Post 30 in Lancaster and as a board member of the United Veterans Beacon House.
