Ronald S. “Ron” Drotos, 86, of Mount Joy, passed away on Thursday, October 30, 2025 at Lancaster Nursing and Rehabilitation. Born in Passaic, NJ, he was the son of the late Steve and Mary (Papachic) Drotos. Ron was the husband of Mary (Mineo) Drotos with whom he celebrated 64 years of marriage this past May 7th.

Ronald proudly served in the United States Navy from 1957 to 1961. Ron started out working at ADT and later served 25 years as a police officer with the Wood-Ridge NJ Police Department, retiring as a lieutenant in 1992. While on the police force, Ron was a firearms instructor and a Top Marksman in the State of New Jersey. 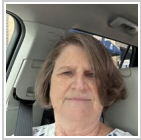
