“ I’ve been Shannon’s supervisor at Clipper since she started, and I was one of the managers who did her interview. Her interview continues to stick out as one of the most impactful ones I’ve had, and I have told the story of her interview multiple times since. During the interview we got to a pretty standard question - “can you tell us about a mistake you’ve made in the job and what you learned from it?”. And I know I’ll get some of these details wrong, but Shannon told us about a time at Harvest when she missed something about an allergy a kid had at a table she was serving. The kid had a reaction but was ultimately fine. As Shannon recalled the story, she started to cry. I’d never had anyone have that kind of reaction during an interview. But at that point, as far as I was concerned, she had the job. Anyone who cares that much about the responsibility to, and impact on that family as her customers, was going to be great. I can teach someone how to do a customer service job, but having that kind of care and passion is just innate. And as expected, she was amazing at her job. She worked hard, genuinely loved what she did and formed so many important relationships. She made the team laugh and shared her odd facts and stories. Her teammates, sales reps and customers loved working with her. Shannon was special and it was a joy to work with her and get to know her for the time that we had. She will be incredibly missed, and the story of her interview will stick with me forever.
