William L. "Bill" Hayman, 63 of Manheim and formerly of Mount Joy passed away on Thursday, December 17, 2020. Born in Lancaster, Bill was the son of the late Warren "Whitey" and Jeanette Nissley Hayman. Bill is survived by two sons, Patrick M. Hayman of Lancaster, and Wesley Hayman, companion of Melissa Naylor of Horsham and their daughter, Bills "darling granddaughter Hannah."
