



## William "Terry" Terrance Murray

William "Terry" Terrance Murray, 70, of Elizabethtown, PA lost his battle with complications of a lifelong illness on April 6, 2026. He was born on November 30, 1955 in Joplin MO and was raised in Salina, KS. Terry attended Salina High School, Salina, KS and graduated in 1974. Terry enlisted in the United States Air Force on September 10, 1974. He was Honorably Discharged on March 15, 1979. After discharge, Terry used the GI Bill to obtain a Bachelor's Degree in Business from Delaware State.

During Terry's tour of duty at Kelly AFB, TX, he met his future wife who was also stationed at the base. Terry married Susan Carole (Ellinger) Murray on July 15, 1977 in San Antonio, TX. They celebrated 48 years of marriage in July 2025.

Terry was preceded in death by his mother Rosa Mae Bock on February 23, 2016 and his father James Leland Murray on April 17, 2025.

Terry was a long-time member of the Knights of Columbus Council 867. Terry worked as a production planner in several manufacturing plants in Lancaster and York Counties, PA until his retirement in 2018.

Terry was a member of the National Scleroderma Foundation and an advocate for animals. He shared a love of bowling with his son, Terry, and he also enjoyed participating with his children whether it was Little League, outdoor camping, or the Boy Scouts of America. Terry was a lifelong supporter of the Kansas City Chiefs football team. He and his wife enjoyed visiting the many lighthouses in America.
